Is your business cyber ready? Cybercrime is real and it can impact your business. The list below can help evaluate your business' cyber readiness, and help you identify areas where change is needed.

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✓ Back up your data on a regular basis.* ✓ Secure your network, and have a firewall in place.* ✓ Encrypt your data.* ✓ Set-up antivirus software on all devices, and keep it up to date.* ✓ Keep software updated on all your devices, including mobile devices. Many software updates provide security updates; failing to update your devices can leave vulnerabilities exposed. ✓ Use email spam filters to reduce the amount of phishing emails. Phishing emails are a common tactic among cyber criminals to infect devices and steal confidential information. ✓ Use Multi-Factor Authentication <ul style="list-style-type: none"> » This verification process requires users to provide two or more proofs of their identities to access their accounts. For example, signing into an application or website requires a code to be sent to a separate device that the user registers, like a cell phone, before granting access. ✓ Train employees <ul style="list-style-type: none"> » Communication is key. Provide regular training to employees to recognize signs of a cyber-attack and create policies to guide employees on best practices for cyber security. ✓ Develop an incident response plan <ul style="list-style-type: none"> » The Risk-Can Cyber Insurance Policy provides important coverage for incident response expenses in the event of a data breach, such as IT forensics to establish the cause, credit monitoring services, legal and public relations advice, and customer notification. ✓ Be compliant with the Payment Card Industry (PCI) Data Security Standards. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> » PCI compliance is compulsory for all organizations that accept, transmit or store credit card data. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✗ Rely on one data backup. ✗ Rely on personal/ consumer level firewalls. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> » AVAST Business CloudCare is commercial grade. ✗ Connect or plug in with any unknown device(s). <ul style="list-style-type: none"> » Allowing third-party vendors temporary access can leave you vulnerable to a cyber-attack. ✗ Allow employees to download programs without IT management or permission. ✗ Assume all threats are external. ✗ Be complacent about cybersecurity. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> » Be proactive and purchase a cyber insurance policy for further protection.
